## Wolds Ward Laceby Update March 2023

## Crime

There have been forty-seven reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for February. Of these, the following have occurred in Laceby village.

Overnight 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> February an outbuilding at a farm on New Road Laceby was attacked by persons smashing through the brick wall. The shutter was also forced. Despite the building being entered, it appears nothing was stolen.

Over the same period, a cow shed at another farm on New Road was entered. A quad bike was removed from a trailer, which was later found a short distance away.

A MAN Truck tower wagon has been stolen from The Manor House, Grimsby Road, Laceby between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> February.

Crops were damaged in a field off Caistor Road after a vehicle was driven across the field. A van parked on Caistor Road was damaged when a wing mirror was broken off.

Other crimes include:

One assault.

Two reports of harassment.

One report of sending malicious communications.

Five reports of minor public order incidents.

There were two reports of ASB within Laceby village, which were both neighbour disputes.
