Wolds Ward Laceby Update February 2024

Crime

There have been thirty two reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for January.

Just after midnight on 24th January a resident on Kenmar Road looked out his window and witnessed his camper van being stolen. The vehicle collided with the garden wall as it was being driven away. One man has been charged with offences in relation to this offence.

Damage has been caused to a vehicle parked on Church Lane, Laceby over the past five months.

There was one other offence which was a minor assault.

There has been one report of ASB within Laceby village, in relation to the illegal use of motorbikes around the village.
