

Wolds Ward Laceby Update August 2022

Crime

There were twenty six reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for July. Of these, the following have occurred in Laceby village.

On the evening of 4th July intruders entered the compound of the Laceby Manor Golf Course. After using angle grinders to cut locks off a gate securing a dutch barn, they stole a maintenance vehicle from within.

Other crime include: Graffiti was sprayed on to a garden wall at St Francis Grove. Two assaults. Two minor public order offences. One report of harassment.

There were five reports of ASB. Three reports regarding the same neighbour dispute. Youths causing issues on St Francis Grove Park. Report regarding the travellers on the field adjacent to Morrison's
