The Chair opened the VE Day Planning Meeting, welcoming everyone to the meeting.

## **Bunting & Flags**

- Cllr Metcalf opened the meeting advising that she had some prices for the bunting depending on how much we would want. Various types of union jack flags @ £20 for 54ft and red, white, blue triangles @ £3.99 for 33ft. Flags to wave are 30p each, if purchase over 100 they drop to 24p each.
- Mrs Hopkins advised that she could arrange for her husband to measure up to give us the required amount.
- Mrs Scott explained that she had responded to an email from the Poppy Appeal and had requested lamppost poppies, flags and banners.
- Cllr Metcalf advised that the library would also be making bunting.
- Discussion held around getting residents to decorate streets as well as properties and possibly having a prize for best street.

# Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2020

- Cllr Metcalf advised that she had looked for a Swing Jazz Band & had found a variety of groups priced between £300 & £500 for 2 x 45 min sessions. The plan was to have Laceby Lyricals, Stanford School Choir, Theatre Group/ Singers (Suzzi at Library) and possible music playing through sound system. Clerk suggested that this was all pulled into a timetable for the day at the next meeting.
- Mr Hewitt advised that he would contact someone to see if they were available to play music on the day.
- Mr Hewitt also confirmed that Gary, a Piper, was available for the afternoon between 12pm and 3pm on the day.
- Cllr Dixon asked if the school had a stage that we could have outside for the use of the singers / band etc. Cllr Metcalf will check with Mrs Hackfath.
- Cllr Schofield has advised that the Pink Pig (Scunthorpe) will loan us 35 straw bales if we collect and return them – we will need volunteers with trailers or to hire a van to do this.
- Mrs Smith confirmed that her husband was available to provide 1<sup>st</sup> Aid cover for the day.
- The Clerk advised that a Risk Assessment will need to be carried out to check we have everything covered.
- Mrs Broughton offered to contact One Stop for prizes for the day and Cllr's Greenbeck and Johnson will contact Morrisons and Cllr Metcalf the Laceby Lodge.
- Dress up is optional and this will be 1940's style Mrs Broughton suggested we held this as a competition on the day.
- It was suggested that Mr Pat Anderson be approached to conduct the speech / open the event, Mr Hewitt will speak to him.
- Cllr Dixon will arrange for Nunny's farm to be available on the day and Mrs Hopkins will look to get a Punch and Judy show booked.

 Tea and coffee will be available and the RBL offered use of their boiler for the water. Drinks available from the Stanford Centre – volunteers needed.
