

Minutes of the Laceby Parish Council Planning Meeting held at the Stanford Centre Cooper Lane Laceby on Tuesday 20th May 2014 at 7.30 p.m.

11153 Apologies: Councillor Mrs. R. James and Mr. T. Maione – NELC.

11154 Acceptance of Office Form

The Chairman, Councillor Greenbeck signed his acceptance of office form.

The Chairman, Councillor Greenbeck stated he would follow procedure and would not let all people talk at once.

Councillor Marshall wished it to be known that he had not used his casting vote in respect of the election of Chairman, and thanked those who had voted for him.

11155 Declarations of Interest

Councillor Turner declared an interest under item no. 4 planning matters relating to planning application DM/0487/14/FUL – 9 Whitgift Close Laceby – Councillor Turner completed the declaration of interest form.

11156 Dispensation Requests

None received.

The Chairman suspended the meeting for discussion on:-

Public Forum – no representations made by members of the public present.

The Chairman resumed the meeting to discuss the following:-

11157 Planning Matters

It was noted that Mr Tony Maione of NELC's Legal Department had been due to attend the meeting to offer the Parish Council a presentation on taking over Borough Council Services. However Mr Maione had offered his apologies and was unable to attend. It was resolved to invite him to attend the June Planning meeting.

Footpath no. 111 – Kissing gate – the Clerk stated that Nicola Hardy wished to put forward further information in respect of the existing kissing gate which the Parish Council wished to have retained on this footpath. The Clerk informed those present that the present kissing gate did not meet current legislation regarding disabled people and may have to be removed permanently. The Clerk stated that Nicola Hardy was to send further

information in an email for the next meeting; but had only become aware of the Parish Council's request to keep the kissing gate when the Clerk had copied her into emailed correspondence with Mr Anthony Snell of the Public Rights of Way Dept at NELC.

DM/0487/14/FUL – Loft Conversion with one dormer to rear and two dormers to the front at 9 Whitgift Close Laceby.

Members considered plans provided by NELC to ensure that the dormers on the application did not overlook neighbouring gardens or properties too much. Discussions took place and it was resolved that there would be no objections to this planning application.

11158 Allotment Matters

A letter from the tenant of plot number 12 had been received by the Clerk in respect of bees on the allotments; and it was agreed to put this matter on the June agenda and circulate the correspondence received to all members of the Parish Council.

Councillor Schofield stated that one of the existing tenants would like to put weed killer on allotment number 34 or 35 an existing vacant plot. The Clerk was to check the plot number.

Councillor Metcalf queried from this meeting that if no one was renting this plot was it ok for weed killer to be used. It was resolved that this was acceptable subject to the Clerk letting Councillor Schofield know what the vacant plot number was.

Councillor Marshall made mention of the problems with the mini roundabout that had been installed at the Aylesby junction and wanted this to be put on the next agenda.

The Clerk informed him that Councillor Grimley had already made a request regarding this matter to be put on the agenda.

Councillor Marshall stated that it should be remembered that the Laceby Road Safety Partnership had been involved with this.

The Chairman declared the meeting closed at 8.05 p.m.
