There have been thirty nine recorded crimes across the Wolds Ward for September. Of these, the following have occurred in Laceby village.

Graffiti was sprayed on a telecoms box on Grimsby Road.

A windowpane of a home on Caistor Road was damage after an air pellet was fired at it.

Other crime include:

Threats to cause damage to a campervan during a neighbour dispute over parking.

Three reports of harassment.

One Shop Theft.

One making off without payment for fuel from Laceby Lodge.

Theft of golf clubs from a garden on High Street. These were abandoned outside the address.

There were no reports of ASB.
